SUBJEC	T: REPORTING LOSS OF DE	PARTMENTAL	ASSETS

- 1. It has been observed during verification of assets that officials do not report loss/stolen departmental assets in their responsibility.
- 2. The following procedure must to be followed when reporting loss/stolen of departmental assets:

Any loss due to criminal activity shall immediately be reported to the nearest South African Police Service station (SAPS) and the information accordingly be provided to the Security Management Unit.

- a) The information referred to in the paragraph above shall include:
 - i) the relevant SAPS Station of Office;
 - ii) the case number of the loss;
 - iii) details of the investigating officer; and
 - iv) a copy of statement provided to the police.

After a loss has been reported, the person responsible for the assets lost must compile a loss/ stolen or damage report which will be issued by Security Management Unit. Security Management Unit will further conduct a preliminary investigation by completing a questioner form with the person affected by the loss.

An investigation will be conducted and a formal report that determine if a loss of an asset is irrecoverable or irrecoverable:

Recoverable losses (avoidable losses) will be recovered by the person responsible for the assets lost due to his/her act or omission, or negligence to safeguard the assets including:

- Misusing and abusing of assets
- Unlawful acts
- Leaving assets in a motor vehicle, like laptops, cellphones, hard-drives, cameras.
- Leaving laptops, camera's, cellphone in unlocked, unattended offices
- Irrecoverable assets will be written off by the department
