Know Your Data

- Get Familiar with What POPIA Considers Personal Information! This includes things like names, addresses, email addresses, financial info, and health records.
- Only gather and use personal information if it's essential for your task. Remember, safeguarding data isn't just a rule; it's about building trust with our clients and each other!



Secure Your Devices

- **Supercharge Your Passwords:** Create strong, unique passwords for all your work and personal accounts.
- Stay Safe, Stay Updated: Keep your devices protected by installing the latest software updates.
- Watch Out for Phishing: Always be cautious of suspicious emails or texts that might trick you.
- **Wi-Fi Wisely:** Avoid using public Wi-Fi for important tasks. Stick to secure networks.



Be Cyber Aware

- Keep up-to-date with the latest cybersecurity threats and best practices.
- If you notice any unusual activity, report it to your IT department or security officer immediately.



Comply with POPIA

- **Know Your Rights:** Familiarize yourself with your rights under POPIA, including the right to access, correct, or delete your personal information.

- **Report Breaches:** If a data breach occurs, report it to the Information Regulator and affected individuals as required by POPIA.
